

April 27, 2022, Special Board Meeting

Wednesday, April 27, 2022, at 5:30 p.m., Chairperson Mark Stauber called the meeting to order. The meeting was held at Pentoga Park. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll call was taken with the following members present: Chairperson Mark Stauber, Commissioners Patti Peretto, Mike Stafford, Jacob Conery and Jeff Ofsdahl.

Also present: Facility and Grounds workers John Lortie, Chris West, Rob Olsen, Dan Hinch of the Parks and Rec. Committee and Deputy Clerk Amy Donati.

New Business:

The only item on the agenda was discussion and possible action on current rules for campers and the patrons of Pentoga Park. Chairman Stauber discussed the current rules of Pentoga Park with special attention given to current rules on golf cart use and maximum amount of vehicle per camp site. Chris West was able to inform the Commissioners about current issues and golf cart use and how the abundance of cars in the camp ground has been handled in the past.

Peretto asked about the current upgrade to the water system and inquired about upgrading the electrical for the park. John Lortie was able to inform the Commissioners that the water system will be completed as soon as the last part arrives. Lortie also informed the board that he has looked into upgrading the electrical for the park. He said anything can be upgraded but it would be expensive to the County to complete and electrical upgrade as additional transformers are needed.

Conery brought up the suggestion of possibly looking into solar lights for the bath house on the beach. Stafford asked about the possibility of having a signature page added to the rules and regulations for campers' signature; Christ West could retain the signature page.

Public Comment:

Stauber called for Public Comment.

Paul Meinke stated that he was an avid camper and has enjoyed Pentoga Park for years. He also informed the board that September would mark the 100th year of the Native American Burial ground at Pentoga. He thought it would be nice if the board could put something together for that.
