Moved by Leonoff, supported by Aho to approve committee meeting minutes of May 30, 2018. Voice vote, motion carried.

Moved by Aho, supported by Peretto to approve the agenda. Voice vote, motion carried.

Peretto called for public comment three times. No comment voiced.

New Business

Administrator Smith provided a spread sheet regarding the overtime Schmidt feels she is due. Labor attorney Girard answered questions regarding the dispute between the overtime Schmidt feels she is due verses the county's figures. The overtime hours date back to the time Schmidt worked in both the Trial Court and Central Dispatch. Trial Court wages are covered by a grant. The grant is not available for overtime. Lorenz mentioned the county is required by law to go back two years for overtime. Discussion followed concerning potential consequences should the county deny the request.

Moved by Aho, supported by Leonoff for the Personnel Committee to take action and review the overtime for the past two years. Roll call vote: Ayes 3. Nays 0. Motion carried.
