A Symphony for Band

Each year since 2000, Dr. Glocke and Ms. Hansen and I have chosen a theme or topic to teach the campers during the rehearsals and evening classes. One year, the theme was musical motives; another year, variation form; then, music history, program music, etc.

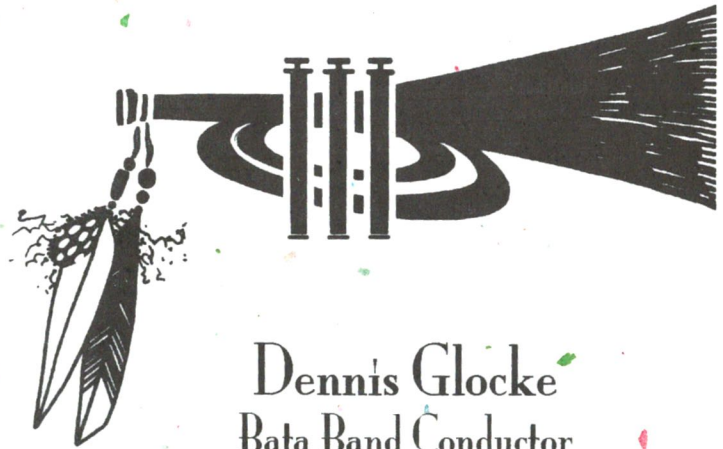
This year, and for the next two, we have chosen to tackle that most noble, yet most difficult of musical forms: THE SYMPHONY. With that topic in mind, the commissioned work this year is the first movement of a planned four movement symphony for band.

During the past week, the students have been learning about exposition, development, and recapitulation of musical ideas. The goal has been to develop their awareness of the most important musical form: SONATA FORM. In the rehearsals and evening classes, we have examined not only the sonata form used in the new work you will hear tonight, but also the historical forms used by Mozart and Beethoven.

To give the audience an idea of what the young musicians learned this week, the camp staff has prepared a special presentation using placard. As Dr. Glocke says, "One needs a road map to understand the more complex and sophisticated musical forms." Hopefully the "road map" of our new Symphony for Band will help you find your way through this sophisticated musical form known as sonata form.
