

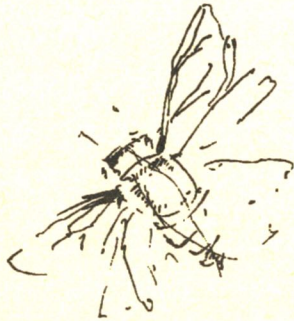
a note from the composer

The theme for the 2004 Iron County Band Camp is program music. Program music is music that describes, initiates, or tells a story. The music the bands are playing and the content of many of the classes is program music.

There is a wealth of programmatic material in the northwoods such as lakes, storms, animals, and even bugs! So I chose to write about critters...crickets, bumble bees, crawdads (crayfish), mosquitoes, monarch butterflies, and fireflies. Four movements of *The Carnival of the Critters* are written as dances (tango, boogie, mambo, fandango) and two movements are lyrical (chorale and melodie.) The intent is to imitate sounds (chirping, buzzing) or characteristics (jumping, soaring).

My hat goes off to Camille Saint-Saens, who wrote *The Carnival of the Animals* and to Nicolai Rimsky-Korsakov, from whose "Flight of the Bumblebee" I quoted the trombone glissandi. With the exception of the movement "Monarch Melodie" my Carnival is intended to be light hearted and fun. As American poet Ogden Nash did for Saint-Saens, some of our students have written introductory poems for each of the movements.
