



IRON COUNTY YOUTH CAMP 2020 REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

HELP US ACCOMMODATE YOUR CHOICE by returning all registration forms as soon as possible. Applications will be processed on a first received basis. Confirmations for all applications will be mailed to the applicants before May 12.

1. If you wish to attend camp with a friend, please **SEND YOUR APPLICATIONS IN TOGETHER**.
 2. Be sure that you and your friend have the **SAME FIRST AND SECOND CHOICES**, for each week or weeks of attendance, on the application.
 3. **Large groups of campers may not be able to be assigned to the same cabin. Every effort will be made to assign you and a friend to the SAME WEEK.**
 4. Include the \$50.00 registration fee, **for each week** you wish to attend, with your application. The balance (total cost minus the \$50.00 registration fee for each week) is due at the time of registration. Checks should be made out/payable to ICYC. Credit cards are not accepted.
 5. Place a 55-cent stamp, and write your return address, on the return post card attached to the registration form. Do not tear the post card from the form. This returned post card will be your confirmation.
 6. Campers are not allowed to stay in camp during the weekend period. (Saturday 1:00 P.M. to Sunday 3:00 P.M.)
 7. **Campers should send the completed health form with their registration form** (health form is supplied with registration materials). A parent or guardian must sign the health form and the registration form. The health form does **NOT** require a current physical examination or a physician's signature.
 8. We suggest that campers bring a sleeping bag suitable for below 40 degrees Fahrenheit for overnights, bedding for their bunk in the cabin, at least one sheet to put over the rubberized mattress provided on their bunk and an extra pair of shoes for hiking and old shoes that can be worn in lakes and rivers. It is advisable to bring long pants, long socks, and a long sleeve shirt. Tick and/or insect repellent may also be desirable.
 9. Campers are **NOT** permitted to have radios, cellular phones, smart watches, CD players, iPods, electronic games, etc. . . of any type in camp. **Please do not send any food, candy, gum, pop, etc. . . food items mailed to camp will be held in the office until campers leave to go home.** Only disposable cameras are allowed in camp.
- *Please do not bring to camp large quantities of food, candy, etc. Food or candy items in the cabins invites unwanted critters. The camp provides three complete, wholesome meals to all campers each day.*
10. **Registration begins at 3:00 P.M. (Central Time). Do not arrive before 2:00 P.M. on Sunday (Central Time)** In case of cancellation, please call camp (906-265-4476) as early as possible.

11. **FEES:**
1. Children who are permanent residents of Iron County (for at least a one year period prior to their enrollment in camp) pay in-county rates.
 2. A child will pay in-county rates if the child has a parent who is a permanent resident of Iron County who has court ordered custody of the said child for the summer. A copy of the Court ordered custody document **must** accompany the registration form.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Some of the activities you may expect to enjoy while at camp are swimming, canoeing, boating, kayaking, wind surfing, archery, nature study, hiking, arts & crafts, overnight camping, out-of-doors cooking, folk dancing, and camp crafts.

Prescription medications must be in original containers and (in zip lock bag with camper's name on containers and zip lock bag). Epi-Pens and inhalers must have prescriptions with them. Over the counter medications must be in new, unopened, containers. All medications must be turned into the health officer by a parent or guardian at registration.

Registration will begin at 3:00 P.M. on Sunday (CST). Please do not arrive before 2:00 P.M. (CST). Please try to register before 4:30 P.M. (CST). Cabin orientation will begin shortly after 4:30 P.M. (CST).

Dogs and pets are not allowed on camp property. If you bring a pet to camp your pet must remain in your vehicle.

Campers should be picked up between 12:00 P.M. and 12:30 P.M. the following Saturday. Campers are not permitted in camp during the week-end period (Saturday 1:00 P.M. to Sunday 2:00 P.M.) Campers are not permitted to drive themselves to camp. **PARENTS OR GUARDIANS MUST MEET WITH THE COUNSELOR AND HEALTH OFFICER BEFORE LEAVING CAMP.**

Please Do Not Mail: Food, Candy, Pop, Gum, Cookies etc. . . to camp.

The Youth Camp Health Form must be completed, **in full**, for each child attending camp. This form, which is provided by the Iron County Youth Camp, must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian. Send this form in with your registration.

Camper mail should be sent to: Camper Name, CABIN # at the Youth Camp Address.

CAMP TUITION

The total weekly charge for a camper who is a permanent resident of Iron County is \$110.00 per week. The total weekly charge for a camper who is not a PERMANENT RESIDENT of Iron County is \$280 per week. Credit cards are not accepted. Checks should be made out to Iron County Youth Camp.

\$50.00 (FOR EACH WEEK REGISTERED) OF THE WEEKLY CHARGE MUST ACCOMPANY THIS REGISTRATION FORM. The balance (total fee less registration fee) is due when enrollment takes place at the camp.

Any child regardless of race, sex, color, creed, or national origin AT LEAST 9 YEARS OF AGE & LESS THAN 17 YEARS OF AGE, DURING ENTIRE STAY AT CAMP, IS ELIGIBLE FOR ENROLLMENT.

If cancellation notice arrives 30 days before camp session, all payments made, (less \$10 of the registration fee paid for each week) will be refunded. If cancellation notice arrives after 30 days prior to camp session all payments will be refunded except for the \$50.00 pre registration fee.

THE IRON COUNTY YOUTH CAMP IS OWNED BY THE COUNTY OF IRON AND OPERATES UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. THE IRON COUNTY YOUTH CAMP IS LICENSED TO OPERATE BY THE STATE OF MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AND INDUSTRY SERVICES, DIVISION OF CHILD WELFARE LICENSING.
