RESOLUTION
Ballot Language and Submission to the Voters for
Youth Camp Millage Renewal

WHEREAS, The County of Iron has a millage entitled Youth Camp Millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy;

WHEREAS, Iron County Youth Camp has been in operation in excess of 50 years;

WHEREAS, the operation of the Iron County Youth Camp has significantly contributed to the education and recreation of county and non-county participants;

WHEREAS: the operation of the Iron County Youth Camp has contributed to Economic vitality of the county and publicized the features, qualities and Opportunities within the County of Iron;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Iron place before the voters on the November 6, 2018 election the following ballot question:

YOUTH CAMP MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the previously voted increase in the Tax Rate Limitation for the County of Iron ad valorem taxes be renewed at .5 mills (\$.50 on each \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of five years; 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023, inclusive, the taxes so raised to be used exclusively for the operation and improvement for the Youth Camp (Camp Ba-Ta-Wa-Ga-Ma) on Indian Lake. This levy would raise an estimated \$254,112 in the first year. (THIS BEING A RENEWAL OF THE 1.5 MILLS WHICH WILL EXPIRE WITH THE 2018 TAX LEVY.)

Commissioner Ray Coates and the resolution was adopted by the following vote:




