## Iron County Board of Commissioners RESOLUTION

### Ballot language and Submission to the Voters for Maintenance of Effort and Medical Care Facility Operations Millage Renewal

*WHEREAS*, The County of Iron has a millage entitled Iron County Maintenance of Effort and Medical Care Facility Operations Millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy;

*WHEREAS*, Iron County Health and Human Services Board has requested a renewal of the expiring millage to maintain its operations;

*WHEREAS*, the operation of the Iron County Medical Care Facility is a significant function of County government and is necessary to maintain;

*NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED* that the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Iron place before the voters on the November 6, 2018 election the following ballot question:

#### MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT AND MEDICAL CARE FACILITY OPERATIONS MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the previously voted increase in the Tax Rate Limitation for the County of Iron ad valorem taxes be renewed at 1.5 mills ( \$1.50 on each \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of five years; 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023, inclusive, the taxes so raised to be used exclusively for payment of Maintenance of Effort and Medical Care Facility operations. This levy would raise an estimated \$762,336 in the first year. (THIS BEING A RENEWAL OF THE 1.5 MILLS WHICH WILL EXPIRE WITH THE 2018 TAX LEVY.)
