

RESOLUTION
TO ADOPT THE 2017 APPORTIONMENT PLAN
IRON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Whereas, the several Township Clerks and City Clerks in Iron County have caused to be filed in the Office of the Iron County Clerk, State of Michigan their certificates authorizing their levying certain millage to be raised in said townships and cities for township, city, school and other purposes for the year 2017.

Whereas, the tax certificates showing the certified rates, as adjusted by MCL 211.34, 211.34D, 211.24E and 211.34E of the Property Tax Laws, are authorized to be spread against State Taxable Valuations.

Whereas, the certified rates are subject to MCL 211.36 which allows additional millage approved by the electors on November 7, 2017 of a taxing unit to be certified for that calendar year, said millage would require Board approval.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, by the Iron County Board of Commissioners in a meeting assembled in the Commissioners Room in the Iron County Courthouse on October 10, 2017, that said millage respectively be and the same are hereby apportioned among the several township and cities in Iron County in proportion to the valuation of taxable property herein, as determined by this Board of Commissioners in the year 2017 and respective apportioned millage together with the certified and authorize amended millage be levied for township, city and county purposes respectively be spread upon the assessment rolls for the several townships and cities for the year 2017, as follows, to wit:




