Whereas, Iron County Michigan has a population of more than 1,200 veterans, and we honor all those who have worn the uniform in defense of the United States and thank them for their service; and,


Whereas, Those who have worn the uniform understand that we enter this world with American freedom given to us, what happens afterward is our responsibility; and,
