Whereas; The Iron County Board of Commissioners is well aware of its duty and responsibilities to use the public funds entrusted to the County in a fiscally responsible manner; and,


Whereas; it is the desire of the Iron County Board of Commissioners to provide adequate checks and balances in order to ensure that public funds are expended in an appropriate and efficient manner; and,

Whereas; the Board of Commissioners Rules of Order establishes certain parameters with regard to the managing of financial matters by the Board of Commissioners;


Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Iron County Board of Commissioners does, hereby, amend the Rules of Order by inserting the following language, "Payment of invoices prior to their presentation to the Board of Commissioners in order to avoid finance or late charges and to pay appropriated amounts and payroll (including related payroll taxes and withholdings) can be made pursuant to the authority of the County Administrator in a manner consistent with the County's Standard Operating Procedures for Accounts Payable." As the last paragraph in Section 3.6.

Further be it resolved that Section 5.6 is deleted and succeeding sections are renumbered appropriately.

Further be it resolved that the County Administrator is directed to take any and all actions necessary for the implementation of this resolution.
