“As Needed” Positions available through the Iron County Juvenile Office. Duties include: assisting with monitoring youth who need to spend time in the quiet room; assist with transporting youth to and from detention facilities as needed; help to facilitate In-Home Detention programs, potentially including home visits and calls; monitor youth who must be held in a holdover room.

Days/Times for assignments vary based on need. There is no obligation necessary to accept assignments as they arise. Hourly wage averages \$12/hour. Mileage for certain assignments is paid per the state determined rate. Training is provided.

Must be 21 years of age, have a valid driver’s license, and undergo criminal and child abuse registry background checks.
