

**Iron County Register of Deeds is pleased to announce that we have contracted On Q Solutions to scan deeds from 1938 through the 1800s and all miscellaneous records from our vault.** This project was made possible by the Register of Deeds Automation Fund. This is a Michigan State fund that is required for all counties to retain a portion of document recording fees. It is strictly used for automated equipment, digitized historical records, personnel time and upgrading software so the public, businesses and title companies can easily search for property data. When scanning is complete towards the end of 2026 it will then be uploaded to our land records index system. This will still be a monumental project to index the information contained in each individual record; however, the public will be able to use our public room for researching documents online by liber and page instead of having to lift the heavy books. This maintains the integrity of the books along with the capability of sending digital copies to an underground storage company for historical preservation.

Once the documents are indexed, they will be available on our land records index on our county's website [ironmi.com](http://ironmi.com) under the department of Register of Deeds. Currently indexed deeds are available as far back as 1946. This project modernizes the protection of Iron County's land history.
